TRASH/RECYCLING SERVICE

Trash pick-up will be switching to Monday with a tentative start date of December 6, 2021. As part of the new contract, all residents will receive a 95 gallon recycling cart. Recycling will remain every other week. A schedule will be available at the township hall and on our website.

ICE RINK IS MOVING!

The ice rink will now be located behind the new township hall, 7400 E. Houghton Lake Dr. As soon as weather permits, the rink will be ready to use. The rink will be lit till 10:00 PM.

DOG LICENSES

Dog licenses can be purchased at the township hall until February 28th, 2022. Neutered animals are \$5.00, non-neutered animals are \$10.00. Qualifying seniors with neutered animals are \$2.00. Please bring proof of rabies vaccination with you so the expiration date can be verified.

Use biodegradable paper leaf bags only. Bags cannot exceed 50 pounds, cannot contain anything but leaves, and must be curbside by 7:00 AM.

Be advised that it may take more than one day to complete pick-up. Truck will not drive down private roads; take leaves to main road.
