Minutes of the Planning Commission Meeting September 9, 2021

Meeting called to order by chair Ron Duquette at 7 PM.

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Members present; Hackett, Fullmer, Ciaramitaro, Duquette, Devins and Donaldson and Gardner.

Motion by Ciaramitaro, supported by Hackett to approve the agenda. All ayes; motion carried.

Motion by Fullmer, supported by Devins to approve the minutes as read.

Duquette announces that the Planning Commission is not involved in the decisions regarding a marihuana facility on Flint Road or Short-Term Rentals at this time, those issues will be addressed at the Township Board meeting on Monday September 13th.

There was public comment regarding both issues.

Chair Duquette read aloud the correspondence received from David and Kimberly Meszaros and Martin Meszaros against the Marihuana facility on Flint Road.

Ciaramitaro informed us that she had researched meeting minutes from the Planning Commission as well as the Township Board regarding the rezoning of properties to C2. All parcels presented had the approval necessary. The parcels are as follows:

72-008-027-004-0003 Roscommon County,

72-008-034-001-0020 State of Michigan,

72-008-026-001-0020 State of Michigan,

72-008-026-007-0020 Roscommon County,

72-008-027-012-0020 Blaskey Family Trust,

72-008-027-003-0020 State of Michigan.

All of these properties are adjacent to the Blodgett County Airport.

The South East quarter of Section 1 which is a portion of parcel 72-008-001-002-0020

The South East quarter of Section 12 which is a portion of parcel 72-008-012-002-0030

The East half of Section 24, which is a portion of parcel 72-008-024-001-0020.

All of these parcels are owned by the State of Michigan, Department of Natural Resources.

Motion by Duquette, supported by Gardner to present these changes to the County Planning Commission for their approve. All ayes; motion carried.

Ciaramitaro announced that in her review of Township minutes she found that Fullmer, Devins and Hackett had been sworn in for a 2-year term and will need to be reappointed for an additional year.
